Looking After Your Whiteboard

Before the first use of your new Whiteboard

- 1. If present, remove the protective film.
- 2. Wipe board with a clean cloth moistened with a high-quality whiteboard cleaner or soapy water
- 3. Wipe surface dry with a clean cloth

We recommend the following steps when cleaning your whiteboard to remove residue and maintain the surface.

- 1. Any ink should be removed with a disposable cloth
- 2. Wipe surface with a clean cloth moistened with high-quality whiteboard cleaner.
- 3. Wipe surface dry with a clean dry cloth free of ink
- 4. Surfaces used moderately should be cleaned once a week
- 5. Surfaces used more intensely may require more frequent cleaning

If you suspect the surface of your board is damaged, please contact us for further information on cleaning your board with a cutting compound.
